JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

Must hold a valid Missouri class E operator's license and obtain DS II Certificate from Missouri Department of Natural Resources. Must have a high school diploma or GED. Individual is required to have a strong mechanical aptitude and work in an environment with extreme temperatures, both hot and cold. Physically able on a daily basis to bend, kneel, climb, walk and on occasion lift and carry up to 75 pounds and maneuver 300 pound objects is required in this position. Individual must be able to quickly resolve problems with system when they occur. Must be on occasion available to stay late, come in early or on weekends when emergency situations arise. Must be able to work with minimal supervision and handle multiple tasks with frequent interruptions. Ability to speak and communicate effectively with supervisor, fellow employees and customers. Ability to read and interpret documents such as maps, plans, safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, Board policies, equipment manuals, customer correspondence, various reports and procedure manuals. Incumbent must have excellent attendance and punctuality.
